**INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE:**

To discharge, cautiously remove protective cap from valve outlet. Connect charging hose directly to valve outlet. Do not connect to the high pressure side of any system. Consult Owners Manual

**INSTRUCTIONS FOR DISPOSAL:**

Do not vent residual pressure to the atmosphere. Make certain cylinder is empty (0 psig or less) by recovery of residual contents. Observe all precautions printed on cylinder labels. Do not discard. Dispose of cylinder in approved manner. Federal law forbids transportation if refilled - penalty up to \$500,000 fine and 5 years imprisonment (49 U.S.C. 5124)

**FIRST AID**

In case of contact, flush eyes promptly with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. Call a physician. Flush exposed skin with water (not hot) - or use other means to warm skin slowly
